1. Fill this box with the following items

- One 26.7oz box of instant mashed potatoes**
- One 40oz can of turkey gravy
(or four 10oz cans)**
- Two 6oz boxes of stuffing**
- Two 7.5oz boxes of corn muffin mix**
- Two 29oz cans of corn**
- One 38oz can of green beans**
- Two 14oz cans of cranberry sauce**
- Two 29oz cans of fruit**
- Two 40oz cans of yams**
- One 18.4oz box of brownie mix**
- One 19oz container of lemonade mix**
- One 12oz pack of ground coffee**

2. Place \$15 (cash or check payable to Dream Centers of Michigan, write Turkey on memo line) **in an envelope** and place inside the box.

3. Tape the bottom of the box, leaving the top open.

4. Deliver it to 830 Auburn Avenue in Pontiac on **Sunday, November 15 between 2-3:30pm.**
